The State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) is the Central Bank of Pakistan established in 1948. Initially SBP was entrusted with the task to "regulate the issue of bank notes and keeping of reserves with a view to securing monetary stability in Pakistan and generally to operate the currency and credit system of the country to its advantage". In financial sector reforms of 1994, State Bank of Pakistan got full autonomy. On January 21, 1997 this autonomy was further strengthened when the government issued three Amendment Ordinances.

In order to enlighten the Members with the Role and Functions of SBP, the Islamabad Branch Council (IBC) in collaboration with CPD committee of ICMA Pakistan is organizing a Webinar on "An Unconventional View on the Proposed Autonomy of State Bank of Pakistan".
